Dear Residents and Families/Representatives,

Please accept this letter as our weekly update regarding the status of COVID-19 in our facility. Since the onset of this virus, we have had 48 residents and 45 staff members test positive for COVID-19. Our last positive test was on 1/11/2021.

As you may know, we have partnered with Walgreens to administer COVID 19 vaccines to our residents and employees. Our first COVID 19 Vaccination Clinic was held on 1/8/2021 with a total of 65 residents and 31 employees receiving the vaccine. Our next onsite clinic is scheduled for 2/5/2021.

We continue to monitor our ability to offer outside visitation depending on what restrictions are currently applicable to our facility. We are currently unable to offer outside visitation at this time related to the 1/11/2021 positive case, however, we plan to reinstate outside visits as soon as allowed by guidelines. Until this is possible, we invite you to visit your loved one for a window visit or a virtual visit by telephone or tablet. All visits should be scheduled through our Activity Department, Jessica or Coco at 864-227-9500.

As always, we are working hard to keep everyone in our community safe and we will continue to practice the enhanced safety precautions that are known to prevent the spread of COVID-19, such as only essential personnel are allowed inside the facility and we screen them for signs and symptoms of illness prior to entering. Our residents are continually monitored and staff is using PPE as recommended by the CDC. Staff is frequently reminded and encouraged to practice social distancing and to use hand sanitizer and frequently wash their hands when they are in the facility and out in the community. We ask them not to report to work if they have symptoms of illness.

Dear Residents and Families/Representatives,

Please accept this letter as our weekly update regarding the status of COVID-19 in our facility and notification that we received confirmation that an individual tested positive for COVID-19, which brings our total number of cases since the onset of this pandemic to 48 residents and 46 staff members that have tested positive for COVID-19.

We continue to test employees and residents in accordance with CDC guidelines which includes monitoring our weekly county positivity COVID 19 rate.

We will have our second scheduled COVID Vaccine Clinic, sponsored by Walgreens on February 5, 2021. If you have not yet given consent for the vaccine please do so by February 2, 2021 to allow adequate time to order it.

We continue to provide visitation in accordance with CDC guidelines based on new positive COVID 19 cases diagnosed in our resident and staff population. At this time, our visitation is limited to window visits related to a recent positive employee test result on 01/21/21. Please contact Jessica or Coco in our Activity Department at 864-227-9500 to schedule a visit. We do ask that visits be scheduled 24 hours in advance to allow for coordination with staff.

As always, we are working hard to keep everyone in our community safe and we will continue to practice the enhanced safety precautions that are known to prevent the spread of COVID-19, such as only essential personnel are allowed inside the facility and we screen them for signs and symptoms of illness prior to entering. Our residents are continually monitored and staff is using PPE as recommended by the CDC.
