Dear Residents and Families/Representatives,

Please accept this letter as our weekly update regarding the status of COVID-19 in our facility. Since the onset of this virus, we have had 47 residents and 40 staff members test positive for COVID-19. Our last positive test result for COVID 19 was on 11/13/2020. At this time, we are testing employees twice weekly and residents weekly per CDC guidelines.

We realize how difficult it is to not be able to visit your loved ones without restrictions. We continue to monitor our ability to offer outside visitation depending on what restrictions are currently applicable to our facility. We remain unable to offer outside visitation at this time related to our recent positive case, however, we plan to reinstate outside visits as soon as allowed by guidelines. Until this is possible, we invite you to visit your loved one for a window visit or a virtual visit by telephone or tablet. All visits should be scheduled through our Activity Department, Jessica or Cindy at 864-227-9500.

As always, we are working hard to keep everyone in our community safe and we will continue to practice the enhanced safety precautions that are known to prevent the spread of COVID-19, such as only essential personnel are allowed inside the facility and we screen them for signs and symptoms of illness prior to entering. Our residents are continually monitored and staff is using PPE as recommended by the CDC. Staff is frequently reminded and encouraged to practice social distancing and to use hand sanitizer and frequently wash their hands when they are in the facility and out in the community. We ask them not to report to work if they have symptoms of illness.

As always, we will notify you if we receive confirmation of a new positive case in our facility and we will reach out to you individually if your loved one is displaying symptoms of COVID-19 or tests positive for COVID-19.
