WEEKLY UPDATE

03/05/2021

Dear Residents and Families/Representatives,

Please accept this letter as our weekly update regarding the status of COVID-19 in our facility. Since the onset of this virus, we have had 49 residents and 48 staff members test positive for COVID-19.

We continue to test employees and residents in accordance with CDC guidelines which includes monitoring our weekly county positivity COVID 19 rate and any new resident or employee positive cases.

We will have our final COVID Vaccine Clinic, sponsored by Walgreens on March 5, 2021. This clinic will administer the second vaccine to those who received their first vaccine during our February 5, 2021 clinic. We are awaiting information on how unvaccinated employees and residents will be able to obtain the vaccination going forward. This information will be posted in our weekly update letter.

We continue to provide visitation in accordance with CDC guidelines. At this time we are offering window visits. We look forward to being able to offer outside visitation as soon as we can.

We encourage all residents and families to stay in touch. Please contact Jessica or Coco in our Activity Department at 864-227-9500 to schedule a window visit or virtual visit. We do ask that visits be scheduled 24 hours in advance to allow for coordination with staff on duty and to allow for proper disinfecting.

As always, we are working hard to keep everyone in our community safe and we will continue to practice the enhanced safety precautions that are known to prevent the spread of COVID-19, such as only essential personnel are allowed inside the facility and we screen them for signs and symptoms of illness prior to entering. Our residents are continually monitored and staff is using PPE as recommended by the CDC. Staff is frequently reminded and encouraged to practice social distancing and to use hand sanitizer and frequently wash their hands when they are in the facility and out in the community. We ask them not to report to work if they have symptoms of illness.
