June 10, 2020

Dear Residents and Families/Representatives,

As of today, we have had a total of 42 residents and 30 staff members test positive for COVID 19. The majority of these were identified during our facility wide resident and employee testing which were performed on May 21st and 22nd, 2020. Twenty (20) staff members have returned to work.

Our staff continues to practice the enhanced safety precautions we have previously reported to you through our website and we are closely monitoring the recommendations of our federal, state and local health officials regarding all aspects COVID-19 from mass testing to visitation recommendations.

In fact, as South Carolina continues to loosen COVID-19 restrictions throughout the state, many people are asking when they will be able to visit their loved ones. At this time, the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (“CMS”), the Centers for Disease Control (“CDC”) and our state health officials still recommend we restrict social visitation and only allow essential personnel in the facility. Please understand these restrictions are in place to reduce the risk of transmission of COVID-19 in our facility and to keep our residents safe.

We understand how difficult it has been to not see and visit your loved ones over the past several months and we appreciate your patience and understanding during this time. Until it is safe to allow visitors, please remember that we encourage you to stay in touch with your loved ones through FaceTime, emails, letters and phone calls. Please let us know if you are having trouble connecting with your loved one and we will be more than happy to facilitate your communication.

Please remember to check our website for updates. As always, we will notify you if we receive confirmation of a new positive case in our facility and we will reach out to you individually if your loved one is displaying symptoms of COVID-19 or tests positive for COVID-19. WEEKLY UPDATE

June 19, 2020

Dear Residents and Families/Representatives,

Please accept this letter as Magnolia Manor Greenwood's weekly update to keep you informed about the status of COVID in our facility and what we are doing to keep our residents and staff safe during the ongoing coronavirus pandemic.

Our facility has administered a total of 213 COVID-19 tests. As of today, 43 residents and 30 staff members have tested positive for COVID-19. The majority of staff have returned to work and the majority of residents were diagnosed over 15 days ago and have recovered from the virus.

We are working hard to make sure our numbers continue to decrease. As a reminder, we are closely monitoring and following the recommendations of our federal, state and local health officials. Only essential personnel are allowed inside the facility and we screen them for signs and symptoms of illness prior to entering. Our residents are continually monitored and staff is using PPE as recommended by the CDC. Staff is frequently reminded and encouraged to practice social distancing and to use hand sanitizer and frequently wash their hands when they are in the facility and out in the community. We ask them not to report to work if they have symptoms of illness.

Please continue to check our website for updates. As always, we will notify you if we receive confirmation of a new positive case in our facility and we will reach out to you individually if your loved one is displaying symptoms of COVID-19 or tests positive for COVID-19.

Dear Residents and Families/Representatives,

As we approach summer and states are starting to reopen slowly, we want you to know that the staff at Magnolia Manor Greenwood continues to work closely with our federal, state and local health officials to prevent further spread of COVID-19.

Since our last update, we have administered more COVID-19 tests and have had additional confirmed cases in our facility. To date, 39 residents and 29 staff members have tested positive for COVID-19. While we are disappointed to see an increase of positive cases in our facility, we are not discouraged. We are grateful to finally have access to testing that we have needed since the onset of this pandemic.

In addition to the increased safety precautions we have previously reported, our facility also has a dedicated COVID unit for our COVID positive residents. There are dedicated staff members working on the COVID unit that do not provide care in any other part of the facility to reduce the risk of transmission of the virus. We are committed to seeing the number of positive cases in our facility decrease and we will continue to work with our federal, state and local health officials to protect our residents and staff to stop further spread of this virus.
